How to Obtain your CME Certificate

- The evaluation and CME credit claiming will be available online approximately 10 business days after the
 event.
- An e-mail from Informa will be sent to you with instructions for claiming AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)™, and you will have 60 days following the activity to claim credits.
- Participants will need to be logged in to be able to claim CME credits. Please note that the email address used by participants to log into the event should be the same email address used for credit claiming.
- Once you log in to MyCME you will find the activity and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the evaluation and claim your CME credit.
